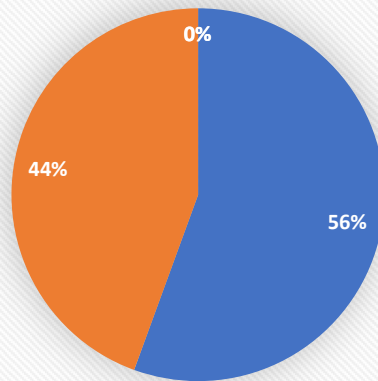

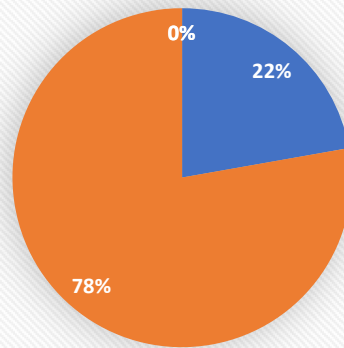
4. How much of syllabus was covered in the class?

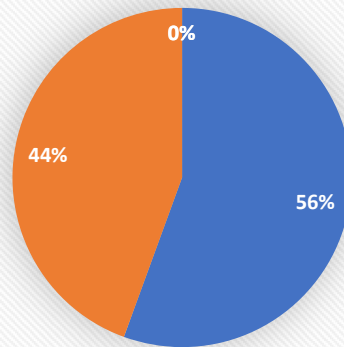


5. What is your opinion about the library material and facilities for the course?



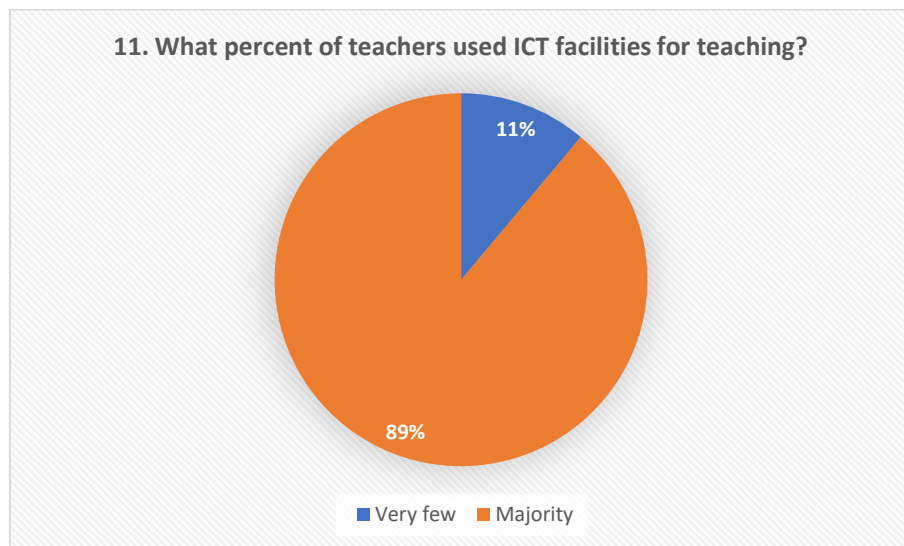
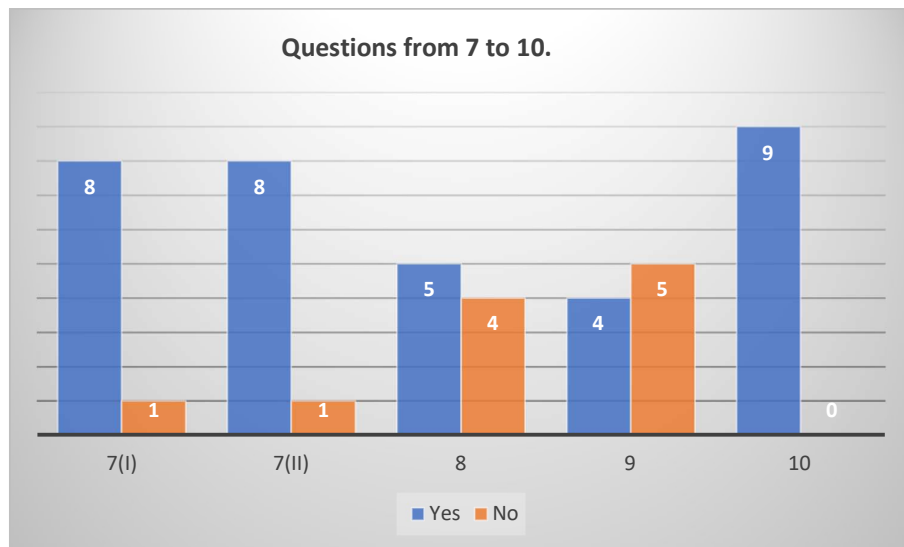

6. To what extent were you able to get material for the prescribed readings?

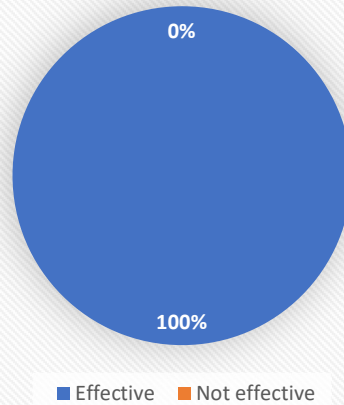


